2024-80 <u>Director's Report: September 2024</u>

- 1. Summer Reading statistics: For this summer there was a large increase in every age group with a 20.8% increase in participation overall. Prize pickup worked well
- 2. Olive Township: Howard Miller's contract with Olive Township expires on September 30,2024. As of October 1, Howard Miller library is extending special privileges to Olive Township residents to continue to check out books from Zeeland only until the November election. If the millage passes on November 5, Howard Miller library will work on a new contract with Olive Township for service. It the millage does not pass, and the Township chooses not to fund the library, Olive Township residents will not have contractual library service.
- 3. Big Read starts on October 1, 2024. The books are: o Coming up! Ask Annaka for Rob if you have questions
